How to Stay Informed & Participate

1. **Attend Meetings:** The Board meets ~4 times a year. At those meetings we discuss the business of the federation as well as news from individual member libraries.
2. **Share InterLINK Updates:** Regular updates are provided on the InterLINK website and in your agenda packages. You are encouraged to share updates on InterLINK activities to your home library Board.
3. **Meet with Your CEO:** Each member library appoints a trustee and alternate to the InterLINK Board. Library CEOs provide advice through the Administrators Advisory Group (AAG). Regular meetings between your library's CEO & InterLINK Board appointee result in better decision-making.
